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## POLICY PROVISIONS

### **Purpose Statement/Rationale**

The policy includes a statement explaining the rationale for a tobacco free campus policy and provides support for key components of the policy, such as protection from industry influence or provision of tobacco prevention education.

### **Key Terms Are Clearly Defined**

The policy includes definitions for all key terms used throughout the policy, including a definition of tobacco and/or tobacco use.

### **Definitions Cover All Tobacco Products**

The definition of tobacco and/or tobacco use is broad enough to encompass new or emerging tobacco products and explicitly includes EVPs.

### **Students are Prohibited from Possession, Use, and Sale of Tobacco Products**

The Policy prohibits students from possessing, using, or selling tobacco products and tobacco-related devices on school grounds and at school events, whether on or off school district property.

### **Administrators, Staff, and Visitors are Prohibited from Use and Sale of Tobacco Products**

The Policy prohibits school administrators, staff, and visitors from using or selling tobacco products and tobacco-related devices on school grounds and at school events, whether on or off school district property.

### **Promotion of Tobacco Products is Prohibited**

The Policy prohibits any person from promoting or allowing the promotion of tobacco industry brands, advertising, or tobacco product marketing.

### **Acceptance of Tobacco Industry Gifts is Prohibited**

The Policy prohibits the district from soliciting or accepting gifts, contributions, materials, or curricula from the tobacco industry.

### **Policy Communication and Dissemination is Required**

A communication plan for all students, staff, and visitors is included.

### **Tobacco Prevention Education is Required**

The policy requires age-appropriate and culturally-appropriate prevention education of all students for commercial tobacco and requires the provision of training and staff development to support the education program.

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## **Narrow Exceptions are Included to Support Instructional Activities and Allow Limited Use Cessation Products**

The Policy allows for narrow for on-school adult use of FDA-approved cessation products.

## **Opportunities for Cessation Access are Provided**

The policy requires administrators to identify and provide access to programs and services to support student and staff tobacco cessation.

## **Policy Evaluation is Required**

The policy requires a regular, at least annual, evaluation to determine effectiveness of the policy and related procedures and/or programs. Related procedures and/or programs may include cessation referral systems, enforcement procedures, tobacco prevention education curriculum and process, policy communication, etc.

## **Supportive Approach to Student Enforcement**

The policy outlines clear procedures or references existing guidelines for handling violations by students. Enforcement procedures for students prioritize education and addiction support, and do not involve suspension or expulsion.

## **Policy Addresses Staff Enforcement**

The policy outlines clear procedures or references existing guidelines for handling violations by staff.

## **Policy Clearly Defines Visitor Enforcement**

The policy outlines clear enforcement procedures for handling violations by visitors.

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
